 - Gymnastics is only allowed in the All-Around Rhythmic/Freestyle, Collegiate Halftime Solo, and Invitational Rhythmic/Freestyle.
- NBTA World's Music will be used for Super X.
- Judges' decisions are final.
- We use the set system! Contestants are responsible for reporting to their lanes on time.
- Contest officials and the school are not responsible for the loss of articles, accidents, or injury.
- Only dance or tennis shoes are allowed on the gym floor.
- No changing tents on the Concourse Level
